ABOUT THE SMALL COIN STRATEGY

Fifth Khagan, LP seeks to maximize investment returns by allocating capital to small-cap cryptocurrencies (altcoins) and emerging blockchain technology enterprises. In normal conditions the Limited Partnership invests 65% or more of its capital in publicly traded cryptocurrencies and 35% of its capital in off exchange investments such as Initial Coin Offerings (ICO) and Private Placements.

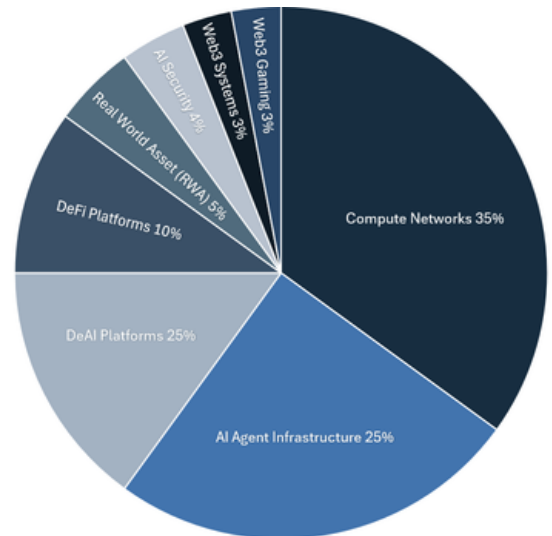
